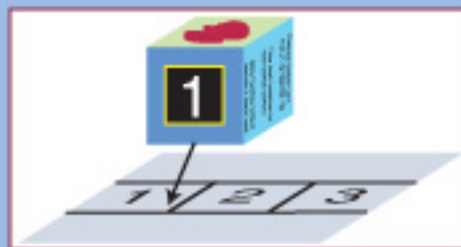


How to use Life's Building Blocks

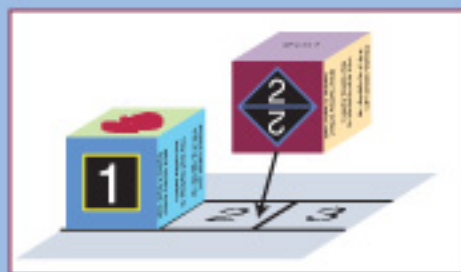
Step 1

Lay the game base down. Read block 1 and look at the illustrations that support the story. Upon completion, place the block on the number 1 space with the number 1 on the block facing your child.



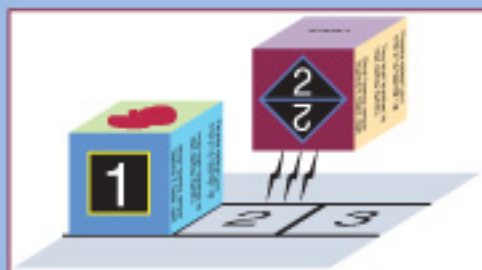
Step 2

Read block 2 which will present a situation to your child. Let your child answer the question. Do not lead them on their decision! Their decision will be found on one of the faces of block 2. Place the block down with the number 2 facing your child with their decision on top. If the answer is correct, the block will be attracted to the playing surface and you will go on to block 3.



Correct Choice on Top

If the answer is incorrect, the block will be repelled. This provides a great opportunity for you to discuss the decision made by your child and why the choice is incorrect. After discussing the wrong decision, allow them to place the block again, with the correct decision facing up, so they can feel the block be accepted, and receive the positive feedback.



Incorrect Choice on Top

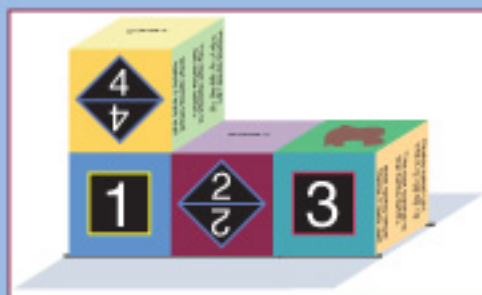
Step 3

Read block 3 and place the block on the number 3 space with the number 3 on the block facing your child.



Step 4

Take block 4, another question block. Repeat the process described in step 2 and place the block on top of block 1.



Step 5

Continue with the rest of the blocks until all have been placed and the structure is complete.



Step 6

Turn the blocks around to reveal the picture that your child has created as a result of their correct decisions. Read the message together and review the importance of the virtue that was being taught.



Step 7 Breakdown the blocks and show your child that another puzzle exists on the wrap sections. Allow them to piece together the puzzle that also includes a message that is specific to the virtue that is being promoted.
